The MOT has approved the OFSC request for a **New extra special early bird** price for the 2014 Seasonal Trail Permit. Purchased **ON LINE ONLY for \$180.00 plus**

\$7.50 processing fee per permit. This is a limited time offer - you must purchase by November 1st.

Go to www.ofsc.on.ca or https://permits.ofsc.on.ca to purchase.

Be sure to have your sled registration details ready.

Don't wait till the last minute to buy, we expect the on line system to be busy. We just got this information confirmed this afternoon October 11th, sorry for the short notice. Please select - Kingston & Pembroke (K&P) Snow Trails Association or Snow Road Club

as your club of choice.

After Nov. 1st the price increases to \$210 until December 1st and then goes up to \$260 after Dec.1st. (application form available on web site)

Don't forget to "THANK" our many Landowners, without the use of their lands we would not have a trail system. Please respect private property and stay on marked groomed trails to avoid damaging these lands. Landowners grant permission for snowmobilers for the use of these trails for the season. They are not public trails for use of other users in the off season, unlawful access by ATV's or other off-road vehicle operators results in closure of trails.

Our trails are open as soon as we have permission from our various landowners and there is enough snow cover to safely groom the trails.

Water crossings will be staked and opened when there is sufficient ice for safe crossings.

Please check trail conditions and observe the signage.

Signage is a key component of the OFSC risk management system, many of the legal claims against the OFSC indicate missing or inappropriate trail signage, please report missing signs to club contacts.
